


WHY SHOULD WE USE REEF-SAFE SUNSCREEN?


Sunscreen is widely used when swimming, diving and snorkelling.

Yet, studies have shown some **chemical compounds in sunscreen** - including **Oxybenzone and Octinoxate - may harm coral reefs,** even in very small doses



These chemicals have been 'shown to:

cause bleaching, harm coral DNA and interfere with coral reproduction in lab-based studies
